### Course description:

This class will provide a comprehensive look at all of the elements that impact a child's ability to eat and swallow safely and efficiently. Information presented will include elements of physiological stability, sensory and motor development, social/emotional components and parent-child interactions. A comprehensive evaluation is essential in order to determine eligibility for services, starting point and treatment goals. Case examples will be used to highlight points.

### Learning objectives:

- Participants will be able to apply course learning immediately to identify children who are appropriate for oral functional therapy.
- Participants will be able to apply course learning immediately to perform a holistic evaluation for complex feeding problems.

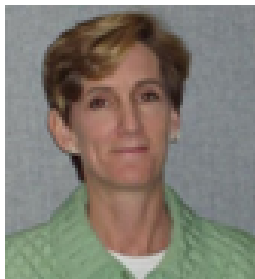
