

# Activities for Motor Skill Development

*Whether your child was recommended for a referral, considered to be at-risk, or fell within age-expected levels, included are some great activities for teaching, enhancing, and/or maintaining your child's skills.*

- Pencil control activities such as drawing a straight line between two dots or tracing lines already drawn for child
- Try vertical line, horizontal lines, and diagonal lines
- Making a necklace or bracelet by stringing beads
- Try making the beads various sizes
- Make a pattern with beads
- Balloon Pass Game
- Have three or more children line up. Have child reach behind their back to retrieve balloon from child lined up behind them. Then the child has to bring balloon forward and pass it to the child in front of them.
- Jumping Rope
- Lacing cards
- Try taking a hole punch to a paper plate and use a string to lace up the holes
- Balance beam activities such as walking on a straight line
- Hopscotch
